



Helen Keller lived in Alabama in the United States. When she was two years old she became very ill., but she did not die, she became deaf, dumb and blind. At first people didn't pay much attention to her. So she had to do exercises all day long. After a lot of hard work she could speak her first sentence when she was ten years old. "I can do everything that people can do", Said Helen. "I must practice more and more to make a happy life".

In 1896 she was very happy because she could go to college. Soon everybody loved her and she was not alone. In 1936, her best friend and teacher, Anne Sullivan, died. Helen wrote several books in her life. *The Story Of My Life*, in 1902; *The World I Live In*, in 1910. Then she died in 1968 when she was eighty-eight years old.
